



Purpose

Ensure that ACS is represented in the EOC Weekly Radio Roll Call and that our radio connection to the EOC is functional.

Scope

ACS Describe what this procedure applies to.

Procedure

Fridays at 2:00 pm local time (may start up to 5 minutes late)

Plan on spending up 15 minutes.

Motorola MTS 2000 Operation

Volume Control ON/OFF Switch ON and halfway

Channel Selector Switch- LCD Display Ops Call (Initial Check in Instructions)

Set Channel Selector Switch to Channel in Check in instructions.

NCS will call roll

Animal Control is station prior to ACS (approx 5-6 min into roll call sequence)

NCS: "Seattle ACS, how do you read?"

ACS: " Seattle EOC, this is Seattle ACS. You are loud and clear"

If you miss roll call and get in late, NCS will call roll again for missed stations.

At end of second roll call, they will announce next roll call time.

Signal should be loud and clear anywhere in Seattle.
